The Destra Preferred and Income Fund's investment objective is to seek total return, with an emphasis on high current income. The Fund's investment manager, Flaherty & Crumrine was founded in 1983, and is one of the oldest preferred securities managers in the industry. Through the years they have built a proprietary database on over 1500 separate issues of preferred securities. Flaherty & Crumrine then leverages their experience and database seeking to unlock hidden value, in what they believe is an inefficient preferred securities market. To seek to accomplish this goal the Fund will, in normal markets, invest at least 80% of it's net assets in a portfolio of preferred and income producing securities. The securities in which the Fund may invest include traditional preferred stock, trust preferred securities, hybrid securities, convertible securities, contingent-capital securities, subordinated debt, and senior debt securities of other open-end, closed-end or exchange-traded funds that invest primarily in the same types of securities. The Fund may invest up to 40% of its assets in securities of non-U.S. companies, and up to 15% of its assets in common stocks.

Some important risks of the fund are: **Market risk**: The market values of securities owned by the Fund may decline, at times sharply and unpredictably, and therefore, the value of Fund shares will fluctuate. **Preferred and subordinated security risk**: Preferred and other subordinated securities rank lower than bonds and other debt instruments in a company's capital structure and therefore will be subject to a greater credit risk than those debt instruments. Distributions on some types of these securities may also be skipped or deferred by issuers without causing a default. **Credit risk**: Credit risk is the risk that an issuer of a security will be unable or unwilling to make a dividend, interest or principal payment when due and the related risk that the value of a security may decline because of an issuer's ability to make such payments. Although the Fund intends to principally invest in investment grade securities at time of investment, there is no limit on the amount of below investment grade securities that the Fund may invest in.

Therefore an investment in the Fund should be considered speculative. Interest Rate Risk: If interest rates rise, in particular, if long-term rates rise, the prices of fixed-rate securities held by the Fund will fall. Liquidity Risk: The fund is limited to investing up to 15% of its net assets in illiquid securities. These types of securities may have limited marketability and may be difficult to sell at favorable prices. Non-U.S. Investment Risk: Non-U.S. companies or U.S. companies with significant non-U.S. operations may be subject to risks in addition to those of companies that principally operate in the United States. This increased risk is a result of, among other things, regulatory, political, social and economic developments abroad, different legal, regulatory and tax environments, less liquidity and greater volatility, a lack of uniform accounting, auditing and financial reporting standards.
