The Adviser has agreed to cap expenses such that the total annual fund operating expenses, excluding brokerage commissions and other trading expenses, taxes, acquired fund fees and other extraordinary expenses (such as litigation and other expenses not incurred in the ordinary course of business) at 1.50% for Class A, 2.25% for Class C and 1.22% for Class I. This waiver will continue in effect until February 1, 2022. The waiver may be terminated or modified prior to February 1, 2022 only with the approval of the Board of Trustees of the Trust. The gross expenses for the Class A, Class C and Class I shares are 4.78%, 8.58% and 5.19% respectively. Class A shares have a 12b-1 fee of 0.25%.




## Portfolio Sector Allocation

## Risk Considerations

**Issuer Concentration in Industries with Regulated Capital Structure:** Over 80% of preferred securities are issued by regulated companies in the banking, financial services, insurance, and utility industries, with the regulatory structure potentially providing insulation against credit default. In normal market conditions, the Fund will invest more than 25% of its assets in securities of companies principally engaged in the financial services industry. This policy makes the Fund more susceptible to adverse economic or regulatory occurrences affecting financial services companies, including the adverse effects of economic recession, currency exchange rates, government regulation, decreases in the availability of capital, volatile interest rates, portfolio concentration in geographic markets, and commercial and residential real estate loans.

Some important risks of the Fund are: **Market Risk:** The market values of securities owned by the Fund may decline, at times sharply and unpredictably, and therefore the value of Fund shares will fluctuate. **Preferred and Subordinated Security Risk:** Preferred and other subordinated securities rank lower than bonds and other debt instruments in a company's capital structure and therefore will be subject to a greater credit risk than those debt instruments. Distributions on some types of these securities may also be skipped or deferred by issuers without causing a default.

**Credit Risk:** Credit risk is the risk that an issuer of a security will be unable or unwilling to make a dividend, interest, or principal payment when due and the related risk that the value of a security may decline because of an issuer's ability to make such payments. Credit risk may be heightened for the Fund because the Fund may invest in "high yield" or "high risk" securities, which involve greater risk, including the possibility of default or bankruptcy, and are regarded as predominantly speculative with respect to the issuer's capacity to pay dividends and interest and repay principal. There is no limit on the amount of below-investment-grade securities that the Fund may invest in. Therefore, an investment in the Fund should be considered speculative. **Interest**

**Rate Risk:** If interest rates rise—long-term rates in particular—the prices of fixed-rate securities held by the Fund will fall. **Liquidity Risk:** The Fund is limited to investing up to 15% of its net assets in illiquid securities. These types of securities may have limited marketability and may be difficult to sell at favorable prices. **Foreign Investment Risk:** Non-U.S. companies or U.S. companies with significant non-U.S. operations may be subject to risks in addition to those of companies that principally operate in the United States. This increased risk is a result of, among other things, regulatory, political, social, and economic developments abroad, different legal, regulatory, and tax environments, less liquidity and greater volatility, and a lack of uniform accounting, auditing, and financial reporting standards. **Currency Risk:** Changes in currency exchange rates may adversely affect the Fund's net asset value, the value of dividends and interest earned, and gains and losses realized on the sale of securities. **Non-Diversification Risk:** The Fund is non-diversified, which means that it may invest in the securities of fewer issuers than a diversified fund. As a result, it may be more susceptible to a single adverse economic or regulatory occurrence affecting one or more of these issuers, may experience increased volatility, and may be highly concentrated in certain securities. **Securities Selection Risk:** Securities selected by the Fund's portfolio manager may not perform to expectations. This could result in the Fund's underperformance compared to other funds with similar investment objectives.
